LIBERALS IGNORE REALITY - CDP

The Christian Democratic Party (CDP) reacted to statements made by Francine Higham, leader of the DA Abroad, by saying “that they are not only naive but border on ignorance”.

According to her, the brutal torture and murders of predominantly white farmers and their families are merely a part of the cycle of violent crimes affecting all South Africans. She had obviously not seen the gruesome photos taken at the aftermath of these farm attacks. If she had she must be quite callous to call them part of a normal cycle of crime. This also renders hollow her statement that the DA has been putting pressure on the South African government to prioritise rural safety - something they must have been doing in secret and obviously without success.

To call recent protests in Australia and Belgium, drawing attention to these farm murders, “misinformed and untrue narrative”; and calls by Australian senators to consider a special intake of white farmers from South Africa “discriminatory”; clearly shows where her priorities lie.

Her liberal obsession with building an inclusive and non-racial society in South Africa has blinded her to the plight of a minority being discriminated against on a daily basis by the government’s AA, BEE and quota policies and who are increasingly being victimized and now even threatened with having their land stolen from them, not only without compensation, but without legal recourse.

LIBERALE IGNOREER REALITEITE - CDP
