NATIONAL DEMOCRATIC REVOLUTION -THE NEW WAVE-

Having successfully infiltrated the ANC and the government of South Africa the communist voice is becoming increasingly belligerent and demanding.

An onslaught is evident on many fronts. Visible to all but those who have eyes and do not, or will not see.

Labour unions are flexing their muscles as their easily manipulated members toy-toy in the streets, insisting on above inflation salary increases and that in spite of a worldwide recession.

Then there is COSATU's crusade against Trevor Manuel, a man with a proven record of success, and their insistence that, Ebrahim Patel, the economics minister, a man with a proven record as an ardent communist, be given greater power in deciding the economic direction of the country.

The alarm bells are ringing, audible to all but those who have ears and do not or will not hear.

Communist inspired unrest within communities dissatisfied with the ANC's

Building on the philosophies of Karl Marx and Frederick Engels they cling to the idea that the "working class" must take full control of state machinery and according to Lenin, break it up and smash it in order to remould it into the Communist model prescribed by them.

Joel Netshitenzhe, addressing an ANC Gauteng PEC meeting on the 15th October 2009 stated "But the first and

most critical act in that revolution is the attainment of state power and the utilisation of such power **consciously** to create socialist production relations."

He highlights the following three points contained in the Tripartite Alliance document of 1998 entitled the State, Property Relations and Social Transformation:

"Firstly, in defining the state and state power, it refers to political institutions and the state machinery. **But it also argues that political power extends to issues of economic power, workplace organisation, the schools and religious bodies and organisations of civil society generally.**

Secondly, our state like all others is a concentrated expression of class interest. It would reflect class contestation in society as it **seeks to fashion itself in the image of the coalition of classes and strata that are the motive forces (drivers) of the NDR.**

Thirdly, because revolutions are at core about property relations, **how the state regulates these and sets out rules** of economic and social engagement is fundamental to the **project of social transformation.**"

The objectives of the National Democratic Revolution are clearly spelt out in the above.

To further add fuel to the New Democratic Revolution's fire, Zwelinzima Vavi, general secretary of COSATU, is reported to have told a SA Municipal Workers Union meeting, that market-driven policies were to blame for the ANC's poor service delivery record and the recession. Without even a cursory mention of the ruling party's incompetent handling of the responsibilities of governance and their squandering of national resources on Black Economic Enrichment, corruption and hugely excessive salaries and bonuses paid to their cronies, he glibly recommended a mass socialist movement, true to Marxist principles and built around the SA Communist Party as the solution for South Africa's woes.

At last the veneer of deception is removed and the true agenda is boldly declared. As if we didn't know it all along.

As for his statement that the free-market system is responsible for the recession, Vavi seems to have a short memory. He appears to have forgotten that the economic collapse in Eastern Europe, after decades of Communist tyranny, was as a result of the same socialist policies he now wants to introduce into South Africa.

The fact is that it is the systematic encroachment of socialism into the freemarket economies of the west that is to blame for the economic maladies they are presently experiencing. Socialism is

totally incompatible with a free-market economy.

It is also important to note the communist tactic of carefully veiled threats and intimidation in Vavi's words: "It is time to implement the policy decisions taken at the ANC's watershed conference in Polokwane **to restructure the economy**. I must say we are beginning to be nervous about the **slow pace** at which we are moving in this **new direction**."

A friend, speaking to an ex-National Party member, and presently the only white member of a Mayoral Committee in one of our Municipalities, was told that if you are not prepared to adapt and to accept the demands of the New Revolution, now would be a good time to emigrate.

Opposition to the ANC, Communist Alliance is almost non-existent. Much is said but little done by the official opposition. There is no evidence of a real plan of action that focuses on stopping this total onslaught.

The more concessions are made the more ground will be gained. The less resistance to their plans the sooner their aims will be realised.

Away, with religion, it is the opium of the masses! Come and worship at the atheistic, shrine of the State and we will supply all your needs. We will run the affairs of state and interfere in the affairs of organs of civil society. All will be well, as long as you follow the restrictive rules we lay down for you.

Mr Pietersen was reported as saying, amongst other things: "Democracy **demands** that all religious convictions must have a **level** playing field in the public domain and children **must be** instructed....."

He says that religion does not have a monopoly on values or truth and then particularly refers to the Christian Faith.
