It is Time for Straight Talk

I have for some time now tried to restrict myself to not attacking any other person or party that does not share my political ideals, which include issues such as my God given right to choose, conservatism, capitalism, and my unique cultural identity.

Looking, however, at what is happening to the land of my birth - under almost 30 years of corrupt and incompetent ANC rule, and also looking at the socialist solutions put forward by most of the so-called opposition parties such as the DA coalition and the EFF, for our countries' malaise, I have concluded that the time has come for some straight talk.

It was felt that an Alliance - working together based on shared Biblical values - would be the best way forward. When the ACDP insisted that the different Parties be dissolved and absorbed into the ACDP, the participating parties - for reasons that had been thoroughly discussed - preferred to work together in an Alliance. The ACDP withdrew from any further discussions, and not long afterwards announced that they had entered into a coalition with the liberal/socialist DA.

Since joining the DA-coalition, the ACDP has recovered slightly when it comes to their representation in government structures. If political expediency was to advance their political aspirations and goals, then they would appear to have succeeded. For now anyhow.
