CDP veroordeel nog 'n plaasmoord

CDP condemns yet another farm murder

“Rather than unconstitutionally spending tax payers' money on ads to promote the secrecy bill, government should use the funds to improve rural safety.” So says Christian Democratic Party (CDP), Rev. Theunis Botha, reacting to yet another farm murder – that of Mr. At van der Merwe of Bloemhof who was brutally bludgeoned to death.

“There is very little chance that government will spend a single cent on placing ads to condemn farm murders as part of its rural safety plan.

“We urge government to get its priorities right and start functioning like a real constitutional democracy, and care for all the people of South Africa and not only some.”
