“The DA may well be daydreamers as suggested by Pres. Jacob Zuma for thinking that they can win Johannesburg and Tshwane – at least outright – but the party excelling in daydreaming is the ANC,” says Christian Democratic Party leader, Rev. Theunis Botha. “An example of the ANC’s daydreaming is the claim by outgoing Johannesburg mayor, Amos Masondo, that he is proud of the ANC’s achievements in the municipality over the past ten years. Other elements of daydreaming is that “Shoot the Boer” is not hate speech, and that Christians will not react against them for misusing religion.

“In the latest case of the misuse of religion, the ANC’s Gwede Mantashe promised voters water, electricity, free houses, tarred streets and street lights, but only if they promise to pray for the ANC. “Some churches have already condemned the ANC for this, the NG Church warned that it will advise its members not to vote for the ANC should this continue, and the VGK had already given their members this advice.”

“Yet, somehow the ANC does not get the message, and keeps ignoring it, rather than promising to scrap unbiblical laws such as abortion, same sex ‘marriages’ and gambling etc. In fact, many churches are now objecting to South Africans having access to late night news in its literally naked form, as a result of current ANC legislation.”
