CDP shocked by police involvement with stock theft

“The Christian Democratic Party (CDP) is shocked at the news, that members of the police are involved with most cases of stock theft in the Free State. According to the latest available statistics, Free State farmers lose approximately R170 million stock and crops annually, due to theft. Theft of some R44 million in tools and implements adds to this burden,” says CDP leader, Rev. Theunis Botha.

“We welcome the assurances from the provincial commissioner, Gen. Amon Mashigo, that police officers involved with stock theft, will be fired. “

“From the farm workers’ summit in Somerset West where first TAU SA and then Agri SA walked out, it is obvious, in what hostile surroundings, commercial farmers work to ensure food security. To make matters worse, the absent minded minister, Tina Joemat Pettersson, thanked TAU-SA for not walking out. “

“Soon after the summit there was yet another farm murder,” says Botha.
